Tip of the Month – Landing Every Time By Ed Moorman

Don't tell yourself have to touch down every time you make a landing approach. Force yourself to go-around if the approach isn't a good one. Ninety nine per cent of the time, a bad approach results in a bad landing. You should actually be practicing approaches, not landings. When you make a bad approach, go around, set up and try it again. When you make a really good approach, then throttle back all the way to idle and land. Unless you are an expert, the approach determines the landing. When you have a good approach, the landing will just about do itself.
