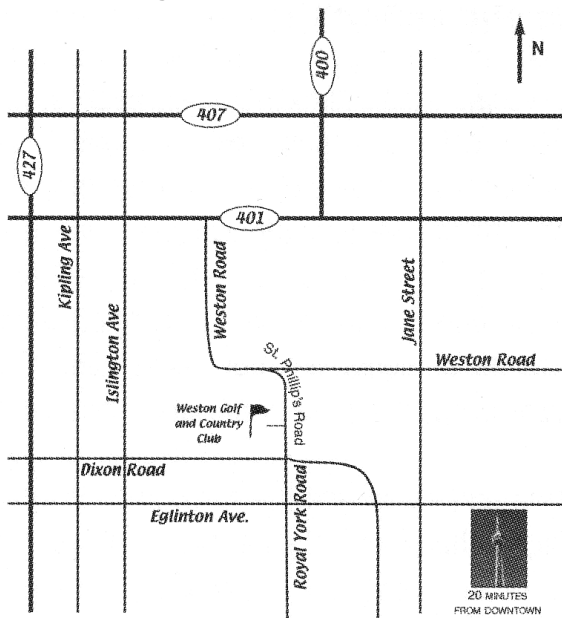

We are pleased to announce a unique opportunity at the November meeting for you to meet **Ted Alley**, Director of Technical Operations for Bombardier's Asset Management Group. Mr. Alley started out his career as an aircraft mechanic but grew to become a senior executive at Bombardier. He has extensive experience in the regional aircraft market and proven track record

of used aircraft sales in Asia-Pacific, North America and Europe. He is an expert on Aircraft Valuation and Pricing, Aircraft Purchasing and Sales, and Regulatory Compliance. He has worked on a wide variety of aircraft including the Twin Commanche, Navajo Chieftain, Beech 18, DC-3, DC-4, Saunders ST-27, Dash 7, Dash 8, and to a lesser extent, the CRJ.

Thanks to the HVRCF Grass Cutting Team



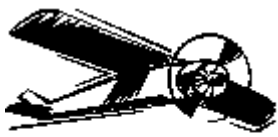

2018 Renewal Reminder

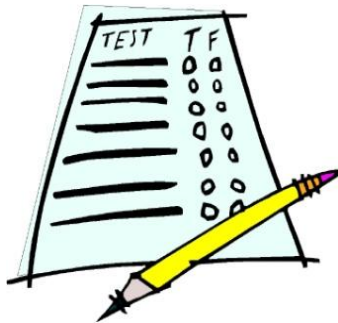

What a deal! After that you will have to pay more. Please try to have the correct amount in cash or bring a cheque to the meeting to renew. You can also mail your application form and cheque to **Bruce Gillespie** at the address noted on the form. It is important to fill in all the required information clearly so that we have accurate data in our membership database.

Challenging Renewal Application Test!



You will find an interesting quiz on the back of the 2018 application form with a few trick questions that you must answer correctly to renew your membership. The quiz serves as a reminder that you understand the key flight and noise rules for the 2018 season. If you mail in the form, you must complete the test or your membership will not be renewed.

Let's lock it up!



Please note that the rotary combination lock on the First Aid Box at the field was found to be damaged again recently and had to be cut off. So we have changed it to a stronger lock that matches the gate lock and has the same combination. You should know this combination. If

you don't, you will find it on the member page of the club web site that requires the member password. If you still can't find it, call or email **Tom Gottlieb** and he will help you out. You should write the lock combination on the back of your member card. We typically change the combination each spring and may change it at other times if we encounter more vandalism. If you are a paid up member of the club, you will receive a notice any time we change the combination.

Remember to log in and out!

Remember that club policy now requires you to sign in and out of the Flight Log Book each day that you fly. The Flight Log Book is stored in the First Aid Box so if it is not open when you arrive, you will need the combination to open it. Also, I highly recommend that you practice closing and opening the lock if

you have never done this because you may need access to the First Aid Kit in the event of an emergency. Note that the combination line is not in the center line of the lock, but on the top dotted line (see the picture above).

If you are the last person to leave, be sure to relock the First Aid Box and Gate locks and scramble the numbers after closing the shank. The gate lock shank should be interlocked with the city lock so that either lock will open the chain.

Finally, please do not disclose the lock combination or web site member password to any non-member.
