

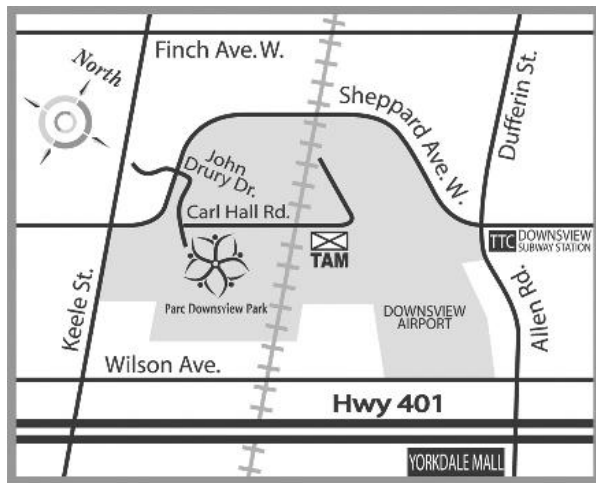


## Humber Valley's Opening Fall Meeting – Tues Oct 4th, 2006 @ 7:30pm

## Field Update – Gate Lock Warning!

Gary Del Bel Belluz got a call from the parks chief recently regarding the entry gate locks. He has been receiving complaints from the York region works department and their contractors. Sometimes they arrive at the park and find their lock has not been included in the chain. When locking the gate, make sure all three locks are joined so **any one individual lock can release the chain**. At this time there are three locks:

- 1) HVRCF and Parks dept.
- 2) York region sewer dept.
- 3) Sewer contractors

These people need access to the sewer trunk line north of the tracks and to the burning methane stack east of our pit area.
